## **Max E. Augspurger**

**M**ax E. Augspurger, 94, of New Haven, died Thursday, May 12, 2011 at Parkview North Hospital, Fort Wayne. Born in Woodburn, he was the son of the late Paul and Maude Augspurger. He was a member of Christ Lutheran Church, Woodburn. He served his country during WWII in the Army Air Corp and was a member of American Legion Post 377. He retired from Rea Magnet Wire Company after 24 years.

He is survived by his wife of 62 years, Patricia; children, Ronald (Marcia) Augspurger of Hoagland and Roberta (Edward) Meizen of Columbia City; and grandson, Spencer Augspurger. He was also preceded in death by one brother; and two sisters.
