Lorenz "Coony" Stemmler, 87, of New Haven died March 6, 2015 at Parkview Regional Medical Center, Fort Wayne. Born in Fort Wayne, he was the son of the late Conrad and Eleanora (Zink) Stemmler. The veteran proudly served his country during the Korean War. Lorenz was a mail carrier and then started working at the Stemmler Shell gas station in New Haven, where he later took over the family business. He retired from the City of New Haven Utilities Department after 15 years of service. He was a lifetime member of Emanuel Lutheran Church in New Haven and the American Legion Post 330.
