Emily C. Bacon, 94, passed away on Friday, January 5, 2018 at Miller's Merry Manor, Garrett. Born in Fort Wayne, she was raised by the late Henry and Lulu (Lichtsinn) Scharpenberg. She was a member of Emmanuel Lutheran Church (Soest), Fort Wayne. She was a WWII cadet nurse and retired in 1978 from the VA Hospital as a registered nurse after 32 years. She was also a member of the Concordia Seminary Guild, where she received the Miles Christi Award and the National Organization for Federal Employees.

She is survived by her caregivers, Larry and Rita Lichtsinn of Auburn; cousins, LaVon (Glen) Rinard, Lowena Sharpenberg, and Warren Perkins all of New Haven; and numerous nieces, nephews, and god children. 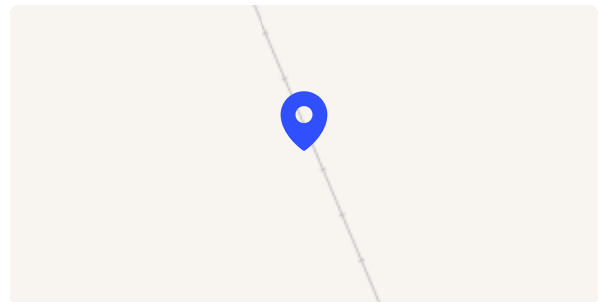
