William "Bill" I. Fanning, 79, passed away Tuesday, June 5, 2018. Born in Pittsburgh, PA he was the son of the late John and Josephine (Strother) Fanning. He was a 1957 graduate of New Haven High School. He retired with over 50 years in the trucking industry, working for both Transport Motor Express and Conway Central Express. He was also a member of the American Historical Trucking Society. Bill was a longtime member of the Indiana Freemasons, Fort Wayne and Mizpah Shriners, Fort Wayne. He enjoyed bowling, golfing, and loved to "putz" outdoors. He also loved his lake cottage and lake friends on Williams Lake and was a collector of Winross collectible trucks.
