Carl A. Witte, 89, passed away on Saturday, February 16, 2019 at his home in New Haven surrounded by his family and the care of Heartland Hospice Care. The US Army veteran served his country during the Korean War and was a member of American Legion Post 330. He retired in 1982 from International Harvester after 34 years. 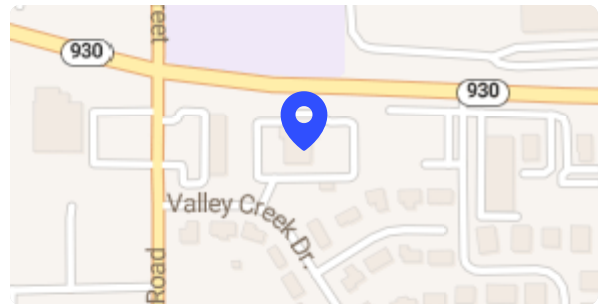

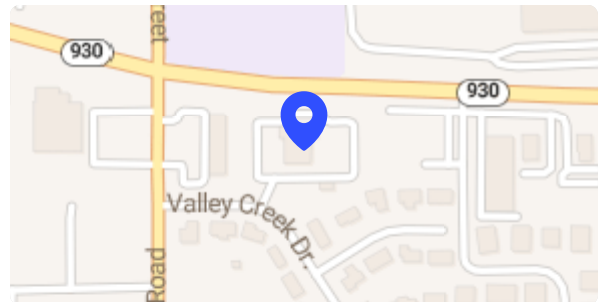

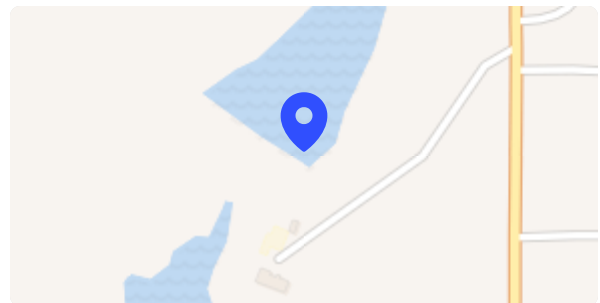
