**G**arold "Jerry" Stippich, 78, passed away on Saturday, October 26, 2019 at Parkview Regional Medical Center, Fort Wayne. Born in Fort Wayne, he was the son of the late Joseph and Jenny (Blair) Stippich. He was a member of Emanuel Lutheran Church, New Haven. He was also a member of American Legion Post 330, American Legion Riders, and Howard Bandelier Jr. VFW Post 2457. He proudly served his country in the Army during the Vietnam War.
