# **Agnes M. Schnelker**

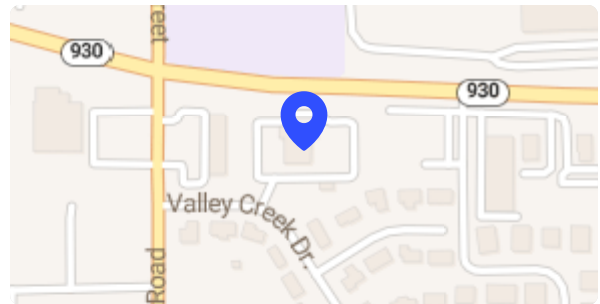
