John C. Waldon, 86, passed away peacefully on Sunday, January 12, 2020 at Towne House Retirement Center, Fort Wayne. Born in Beech Grove, he was the son of the late Jewel and Julia (Dougherty) Waldon. He was a member of St. John the Baptist Catholic Church, New Haven. He served in the US Navy on the USS General William Mitchell during the Korean War and taught Radar Recognition Systems to enlisted men in San Diego. 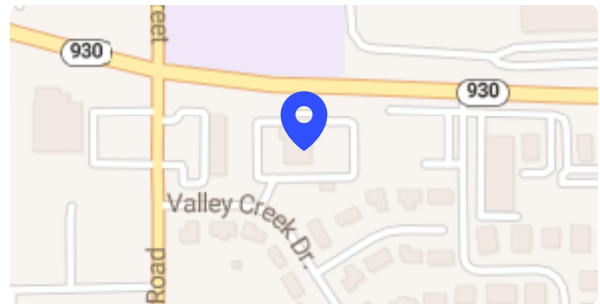

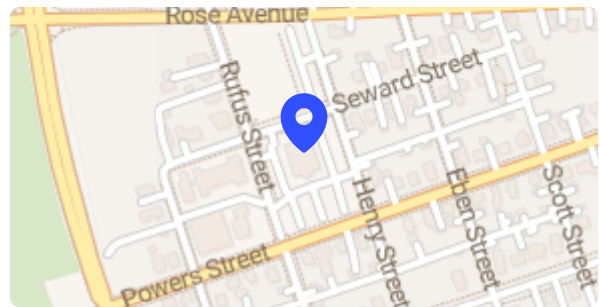

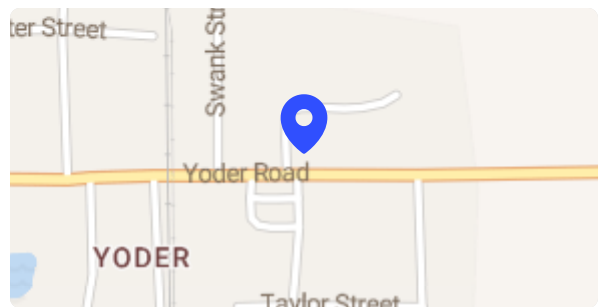
