Carolyn Elaine Hein, 75, fell asleep in the arms of Jesus on Saturday, November 7, 2020 at Parkview Regional Medical Center, Fort Wayne. Born in Fort Wayne, she was the daughter of the late Clifford and Luella (Nahrwold) Heckler. Baptized in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, she was blessed to be a member of the St. Peter's Lutheran Church family. She retired after many years of serving as an administrative assistant with the Fort Wayne Medical Education Program, where she enjoyed working with the residents and staff.
