Willard "Willie" G. Meyer, 84, passed away on Thursday, December 3, 2020 at Golden Years Homestead, Fort Wayne. He was born, raised, and lived most of his life in the same Fort Wayne home and was the son of the late Paul and Velma (Soloman) Meyer. He was a lifelong trustee and member of St. Peter's Lutheran Church, where he was also an elder and school board member. He retired from GTE in 1996 after 36 years and was a lifelong farmer. He served his country in the National Guard, enjoyed lake life in the summer, traveling, playing cards, and spending time with his family, friends, and grandchildren. He is survived by his wife of 61 years, Wilma; children, Linda (Garry) Morr of Fort Wayne, Curtis (Debra) Meyer and Bryan (Shelly) Meyer both of New Haven; siblings, Paul (Kathy) Meyer of New Haven and Leona Thompson of Frisco, TX; grandchildren, Justin (Lauren) and Megan Morr, Madelyn, Christopher, Chase, and Benjamin Meyer; one great grandchild on the way; step grandson, Eric Harmeyer; and step great grandson, Daryn Harmeyer.
