Robert L. Buuck, 89, of Woodburn, passed away peacefully on January 24, 2021 at The Cedars, Leo. Born in Woodburn, he was a son of the late Alfred and Ida (Roemke) Buuck. He was a faithful member of Christ Lutheran Church, Woodburn, and served as an elder. He was also a long time member of Woodburn Lions Club, Woodlan Football Booster Club and served on the Woodburn Lutheran School Board. He enjoyed coaching Woodburn Little League, playing Fast Pitch Softball and following Woodlan Athletics. He supported 4-H, enjoyed raising dairy cattle for many years and was proud of raising a National Grand Champion Guernsey. He farmed his entire life while also working and retiring after 30 years of service from Panhandle Eastern Pipeline. He was married to Loraine (Lampe) for 66 years, who preceded him in death in 2017. He is survived by his children, Jeanine (Vern) Lengacher of Woodburn, John (Sue) Buuck of Fort Wayne and Joel (Shelly) Buuck of Woodburn; siblings, Doris Conrad, Dr. R. John (Lyla) Buuck, and Richard (Jan) Buuck; nine grandchildren; and 16 great-children. He was also preceded in death by his daughter, Joni Buuck; and sister, Nona Wade. Funeral service is 11 a.m. Monday, February 1, 2021 at Christ Lutheran Church, 4412 Park St, Woodburn with visitation one hour prior to service. 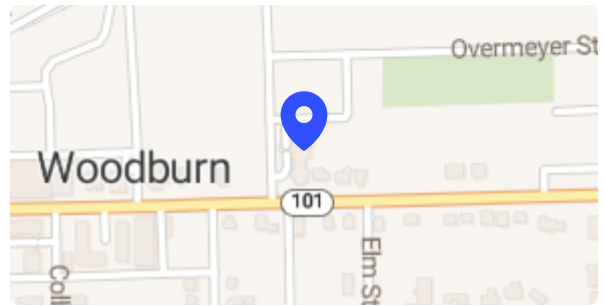

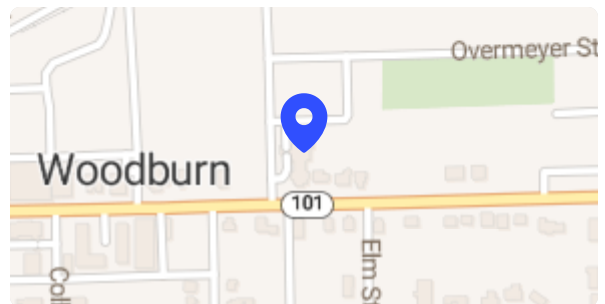

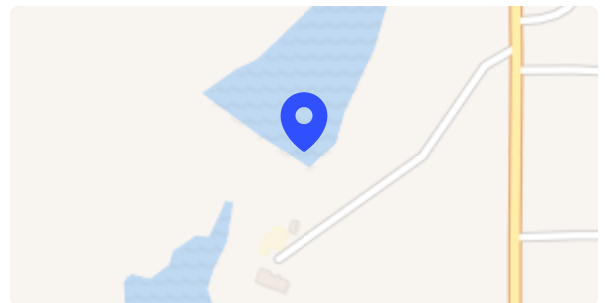
