Flossie Marie Banning, 97, passed away on Tuesday, October 18, 2022, at The Sanctuary at St. Paul's retirement home in South Bend. Born in Noble County on September 11, 1925, she was the daughter of the late Alva and Lena (Shear) Banning. She was also preceded in death by her brother Carl and three sisters, Marjorie, Opal and Alberta. She is survived by her brother-in-law Scott Kamphues, 3 nieces and a nephew. Flossie was a past member of St. Jude Catholic Church, Fort Wayne and retired in 1985 after teaching elementary school for 30 years. 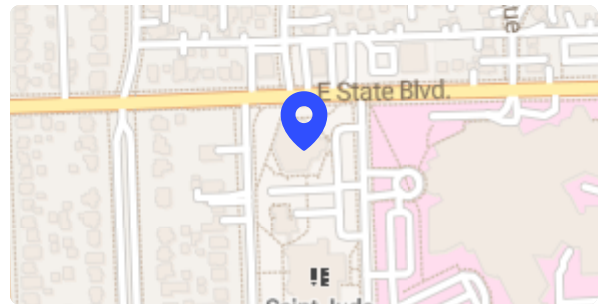

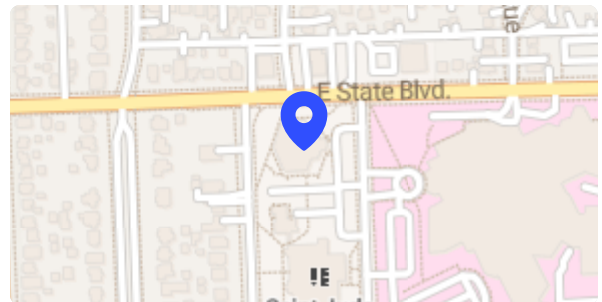

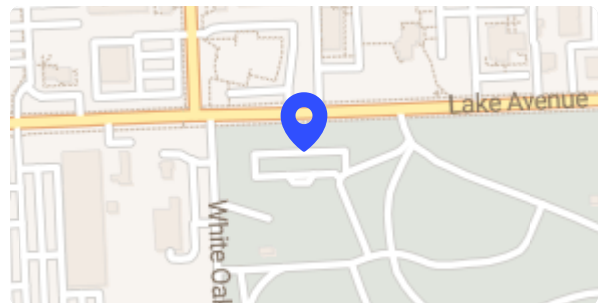
