Steven J. Unsicker, 81, of Fort Wayne, passed away on Thursday, September 25, 2025, at Parkview Hospital Randallia, Fort Wayne. Born in Fort Wayne, he was the son of the late Jacob and Emma (Heuberger) Unsicker. He served his country in the US Air Force and was a member of St. John Lutheran Flatrock Church, Monroeville. He was a lifelong farmer and could often be found helping others after his work was finished. He was a member of the Lions Club, Young Farmers, and John Birch Society. In his spare time, he enjoyed restoring farm equipment and entering the hotrods he built into car shows.

He is survived by his wife of 59 years, Donnalyn (Nord) Unsicker; children, Troy (Shani) Unsicker and Kelly (Anthony) Watkins; siblings, Dave (Dee) Unsicker and Mark (Patricia) Unsicker; and grandchildren, Tyler (Kristen) Unsicker, Megan (Rees) Richards, AJ Watkins, and Christopher Watkins.
